

It all began in 1945, with a single product developed by our founder, Harry W. Hughes. Mr. Hughes was a medic in World War II and his outfit, the 116th Infantry, hit the Normandy beaches on D-Day. Mr. Hughes made it to France and while attending a wounded G.I., was shot in the back by a wooden bullet that paralyzed him instantly.

He spent the next eight years in Veterans Hospitals attempting to medically solve his paralysis. During those long years he realized the loss of mobility would destroy his independence unless he could find a solution. Focusing on driving a car and using his fine mechanical skills, Mr. Hughes, working in the hospital's PT shop, designed an innovative cable operated hand control. Before he left the hospital, Mr. Hughes had over 300 satisfied customers using his invention.



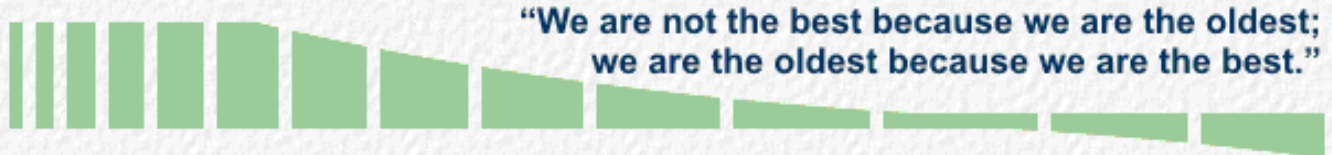
Shortly after being discharged, Harry Hughes moved his new wife and stepchildren to Dallas and began the "Harry W. Hughes Hand Driving Equipment" which he operated out of his garage for several years. The name was changed to "Car Hand Controls" in the early 1960's. During those early years, Mr. Hughes' young stepson, Tom Wright,

when not in school would help his dad build products and install units which proved to be excellent training for his future role. When Harry Hughes died in 1967, Mr. Wright was well prepared to assume the leadership position. The company name was then changed in 1975 to what we know today as WRIGHT-WAY, INC.

What started as a simple business designed to give paraplegics driving independence, has since grown to a company that adapts vehicles, builds and modifies homes and businesses.

Possible Sources of Funding United Cerebral Palsy

In 1953 United Cerebral Palsy of Metropolitan Dallas was incorporated to provide services to individuals with cerebral palsy and other disabilities. All services, except the group homes, are located in a beautiful and functional building opened in 1996 in Pine Creek, just off Regal Row on Harry Hines Boulevard.

The mission of UCP Dallas is to advance the independence, productivity and full citizenship of persons with cerebral palsy and other disabilities. During 2000 UCP of Metropolitan Dallas served 699 consumers through 357,774 hours of service, including 67,429 miles of transportation services. In addition it served 1,540 individuals with Information and Referral Services and 4,556 with public education information.

Of the consumers served by UCP, 35% have cerebral palsy while the remaining 65% have other disabilities.

Major funding comes from the United Way of Metropolitan Dallas, the Women's Guild of UCP and its Foundation, individuals, community foundations, corporations, program fees, government contracts and special events.

The following program operate at 8802 Harry Hines Blvd.:

Home and Community Support Services (HCS) is a Medicaid waiver program, which provides a variety of services according to the consumers' level of need. Services include, but not limited to nursing, attendant care, alternate living residences, therapies, monies for adaptive aids and home modifications. It meets the requirements of the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.

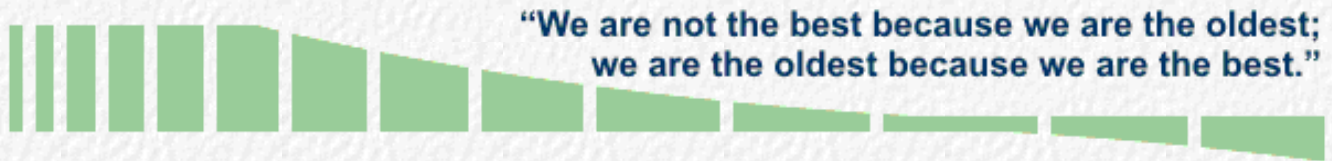

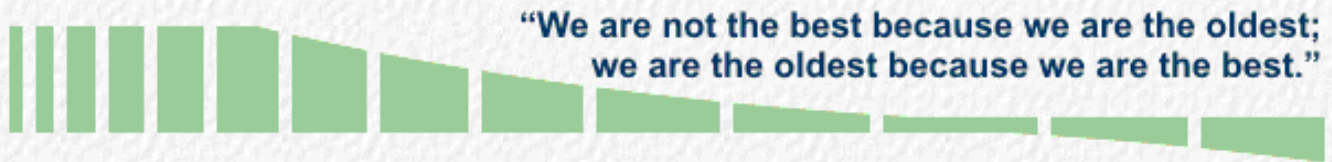

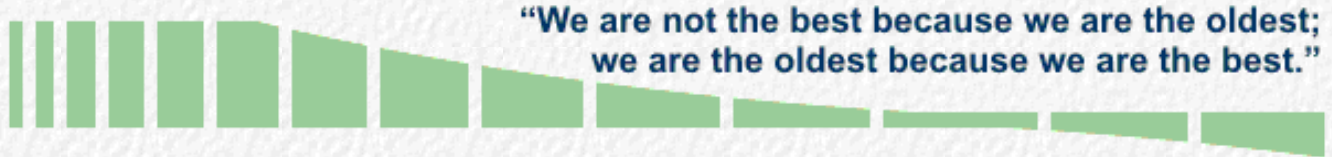

Possible Sources of Funding Medicare

The information contained on this page is also available in the CMS publication titled *Your Medicare Benefits*. This is a 56 page booklet that explains Part A and Part B benefits. You can learn more about CMS at their web site. (cms.hhs.gov)



It is important for you to understand that Medicare does not cover everything, and it does not pay the total cost for most services or supplies that are covered. You should talk to your doctor to be sure you are getting the service or supply that best meets your health care needs.

The amount of your coverage is also dependent on whether you have coverage under Medicare Part A, Medicare Part B, or both. Medicare Part A typically pays for your inpatient hospital expenses and Medicare Part B typically covers your outpatient health care expenses including doctor fees.

A benefit is a health care service or supply that is paid for in part or in full by Medicare.

If you belong to a Medicare + Choice plan, it must cover at least the same benefits covered under Medicare Part A and Part B. However, your costs may be different, and you may have extra benefits, like coverage for prescription drugs or extra days in the hospital. You should contact your Medicare + Choice plan administrator for specific coverage information for the plan in which you are enrolled. If you are interested in seeing what Medicare + Choice and Medigap plans are available in your area, please visit the Medicare Personal Plan Finder section of the Medicare web site. (www.medicare.gov)

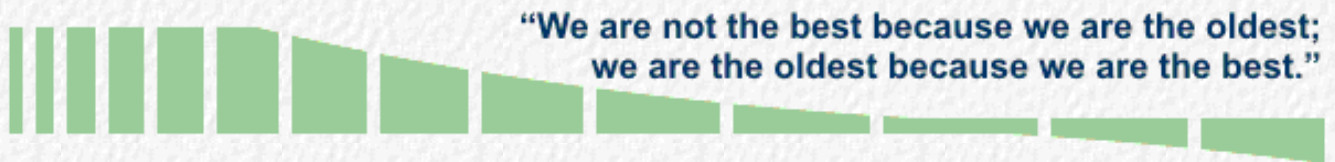

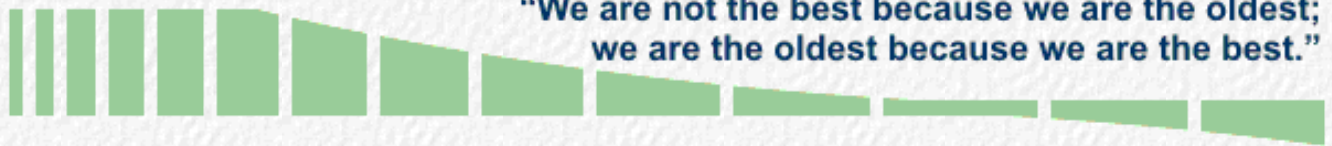

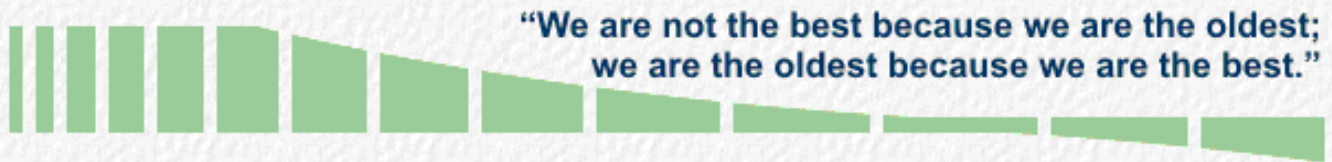

Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation

The Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation (TDMHMR) seeks to improve the quality of life for Texans with mental illnesses by providing efficient and effective services.

Community MHMR centers are political subdivisions of the State of Texas, and locally governed components of the MHMR service delivery system. In 247 counties, TDMHMR delegates a community MHMR center the responsibilities of a mental health authority which ensures the provision and continuity of services for individuals with mental illness. NorthSTAR, a behavioral health service system jointly administered by TDMHMR and the Texas Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, through which mental health and substance abuse services are provided to eligible consumers, serves seven counties. NorthSTAR is composed of the Dallas Area NorthSTAR Authority (DANSA) and a Behavioral Health Managed Care Organizations (BHO). DANSA provides local authority functions and the BHO manages a provider network, including several community MHMR centers. Collin, Dallas, Ellis, Hunt, Kaufman, Navarro and Rockwall are the counties served by NorthSTAR.

To learn more about TDMHMR mental health services that are available in your area for adults or children, you can contact your local mental health authority. You will also be able to access the local information and referral line, which is answered 24 hours a day, seven days a week. These are often known as "Crisis Hotlines". 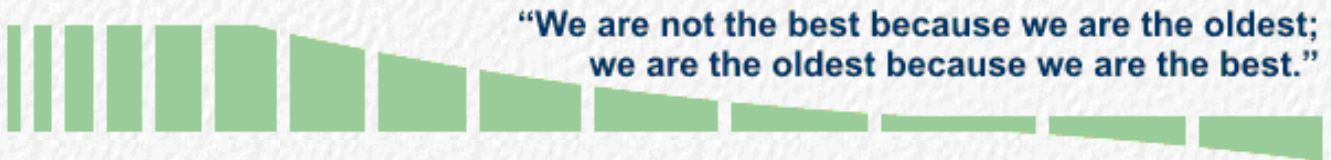

Texas Department of Human Services ~ Medicaid

The Texas Department of Human Services was established in 1939 as the Texas Department of Public Welfare (DPW). When created, DPW absorbed the responsibilities of three former agencies that had operated under the state Board of Control (which is now the General Services Commission). The three were the Old Age Relief Commission, the Texas Relief Commission, and the Child Welfare Division. In 1977, the agency name changed to the Texas Department of Human Resources, and in 1985, the name changed again to Texas Department of Human Services.

Many Texans are helped by the state's Medicaid program. The Social Security Administration determines ongoing Medicaid eligibility for people who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI), while the Texas Department of Human Services (DHS) determines eligibility for everyone else. This includes coverage of unpaid or reimbursable medical bills during certain months before an SSI application. Then the Texas Health & Human Services Commission oversees your benefits.

Through Medicaid for Families and Children, DHS facilitates access to Medicaid programs for recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), low-income children and pregnant women who are ineligible for TANF, caregivers and second parents of deprived children, youth transitioning out of foster care, and certain immigrants. Under Simplified Children's Medicaid, families no longer have to come to a DHS office for an interview and children are eligible for six months of coverage even if the family's income or assets change. The Medically Needy Program furnishes health care for families that are ineligible for cash assistance because their income exceeds TANF and other medical program limits, but that don't have enough income to meet their medical needs.

How to apply for benefits:

1. You need to complete Part B: Information We Need to Know in order for DHS to determine your eligibility for benefits. Part A: Information You Need to Know contains important information about your benefits. Keep a copy of it for your records.
2. If you need to schedule an appointment before you have completed Part B: Information We Need to Know,

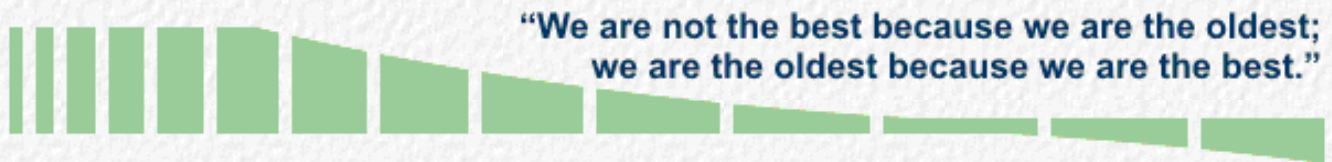
complete the information on page 1 of Part A: Information You Need to Know and return it to your local DHS office. Benefits for food stamps will be provided from the date Part A is received in your local DHS office. You will still need to complete Part B: Information We Need to Know before your interview with a caseworker.

Dallas Center for the Developmentally Disabled

In 1961, two years after its founding, the Dallas Center for the Developmentally Disabled –then known as Angels, Inc.-- was officially chartered by the State of Texas as a private, not-for-profit, nondenominational school for the mentally retarded. Operating initially out of a farmhouse on Peavy Road, Angels, Inc. served children with mental retardation ages six to thirteen.

As its enrollment grew, Angels, Inc. moved in and out of several temporary facilities. A permanent facility became a reality in 1976 with a donation of a tract of land. The next year marked the expansion of services to meet the needs of infants and young children. The addition of adult programs soon followed.

Since 1980, Dallas Center has experienced significant growth in both the early childhood and adult programs. During the same period, the agency broadened its commitment to serve all of the greater Dallas Metroplex area.

Today, Dallas Center works in compliance with: Texas Department of Health, Texas Department of Human Services, Texas Interagency Council on Early Childhood Intervention (ECI), Texas Department of Mental Health/Mental Retardation, Texas Rehabilitation Commission, and U.S. Department of Labor.

ADA Compliance

What Is It And When Does It Apply?

The Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 is a compilation of laws that apply to any organization or entity in the United States that is in the business of transporting disabled individuals.

The actual laws are complex and at times it may not be clear if you are required to meet these laws or not. Whenever a person is in the business of transporting people in wheelchairs, it is their responsibility to find out if their vehicle will need to be in compliance with current ADA laws.

If you find out that you need to comply, realize that the specifications for the chassis as well as any mobility modifications are very specific. This may mean that you might not own a vehicle that will fit under the ADA guidelines. Also realize that while you may know you need to comply with ADA, you may not realize the restrictions this places upon you when specifying a chassis or mobility equipment and modifications.

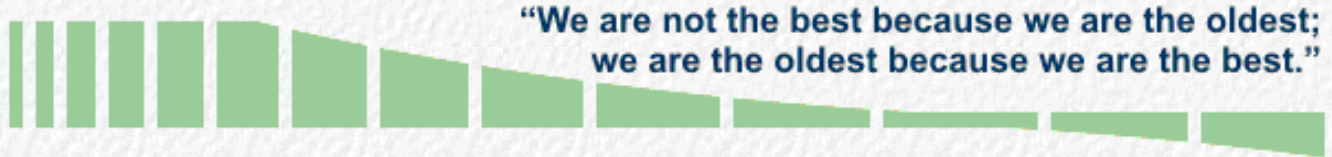

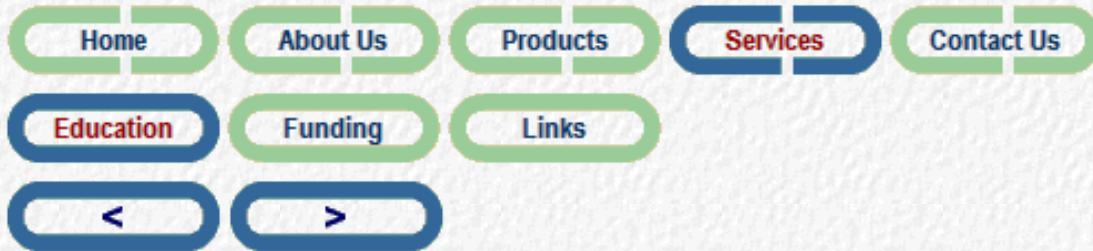

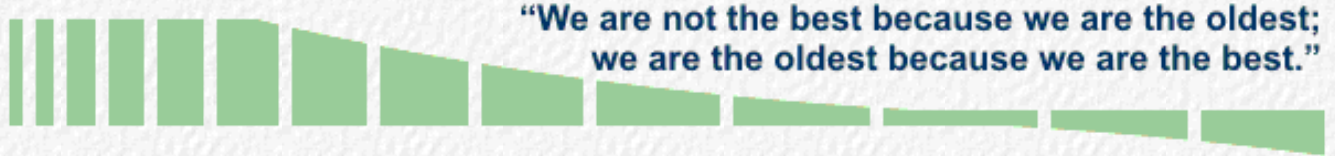

Van Wheelchair Lifts

What do I need to know when I think about purchasing one?

This is a simple question with a 5-part answer. Wright-Way will never sell and install a wheelchair lift in a van without first making sure it will work for the person who will be using it. To anyone who is not familiar with wheelchair lifts it might seem like a simple decision to buy one but you must first answer the following 5 questions.

Question #1 ~ Will the Person in the Wheelchair Fit?

Just because a person is sitting in a wheelchair and just because a van may have a lift or a ramp, does not mean the individual in the wheelchair will fit inside the vehicle. The very first thing to consider is height. What is the height of the person sitting in the wheelchair from the top of their head to the ground when sitting in their normal sitting position? This needs to be compared to the van doorway opening.

Question #2 ~ How Big of a Wheelchair Lift Platform do I Need?

Just like wheelchairs that come in all shapes and sizes, so do wheelchair lifts. In order for a particular wheelchair to fit a particular lift, the overall width and length of the wheelchair with occupant must be measured and then compared to the width and length of the wheelchair lift platform.

Question #3 ~ How Heavy Duty of a Wheelchair Lift do I Need?

There is a wide variety of wheelchair lifts and the cost is somewhat in line with the lifting capacity of the lift. What is the total weight of the wheelchair and occupant?

Question #4 ~ Where do I Want The Lift Mounted in the Van?

Most wheelchair lifts can be mounted in either the side or rear doorway of most vans. Each different place will determine how many seats will need to be removed inside the van and where the wheelchair will be positioned once inside for traveling.

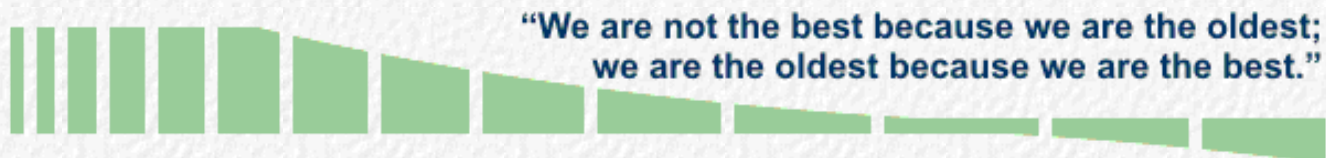
Question #5 ~ What Year, Make, and Model of Van is the lift to be Installed?

Not all models of wheelchair lifts are available for all years, makes, & models of vans.

Van Wheelchair EZ Lock Tie-Down System

Anytime you place an occupied wheelchair into a van then you need to realize that for the safety of the occupant, both the wheelchair and the person sitting in it needs to be properly secured. Just as seat belts in passenger cars are important to reduce injuries while driving on our busy roads and highways, even more so is the importance of protecting passengers who are in wheelchairs.



There are basically two types of wheelchair restraint systems in use today. The first is the manual non-retractable or retractable type of tie-down. These consist of four straps that are secured to the floor of the vehicle with quick release latches. The four straps are attached to the four corners of the wheelchair. The attachment of these can only be done by an attendant as it is not possible for the wheelchair occupant to attach and secure these types of straps to their wheelchair.

The second type of wheelchair restraint system is an electric lock that consists of a special box that mounts to the floor of the van and a bracket that mounts to the bottom of the wheelchair. The way this system works is that when the wheelchair rolls over top of the box, a pin engages and holds the wheelchair securely. To release the chair, a button or lever is pushed to disengage. When compared to the effort it takes to attach and release four straps each time, it is not surprising that this has become such a popular mobility product. This system will work with approximately 95% of all manual and power wheelchairs. You need to ask about your particular make & model of wheelchair to make sure it will work for you.

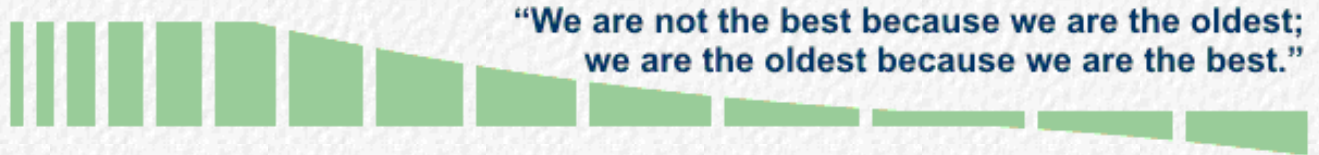


Lastly, whatever restraint system is used to secure the wheelchair is only half the job. It has been proven that even when secured properly, in a crash situation, the wheelchair can literally disintegrate around the person sitting in the chair. For this reason you also need to always use a shoulder/lap belt to secure the wheelchair occupant to the vehicle.

The Texas Rehabilitation Commission (TRC), created in 1969, is designated as the state's principal authority on the vocational rehabilitation of Texans with disabilities, except persons with visual impairments and the legally blind. The Commission's main purpose is to assist people with disabilities to participate in their communities by achieving employment of choice, living as independently as possible and accessing high quality services.

Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) a state federal partnership since 1929, helps people with disabilities prepare for, find and keep jobs. Work related services are individualized and may include counseling, training, medical treatment, assistive devices, job placement assistance, and other services.

As TRC is a state run agency there are strict guidelines when dealing with them. Not only does this apply to specific forms to be used when applying for monetary compensation but also exacting requirements in regards to the equipment and modifications that are allowed under the TRC programs.

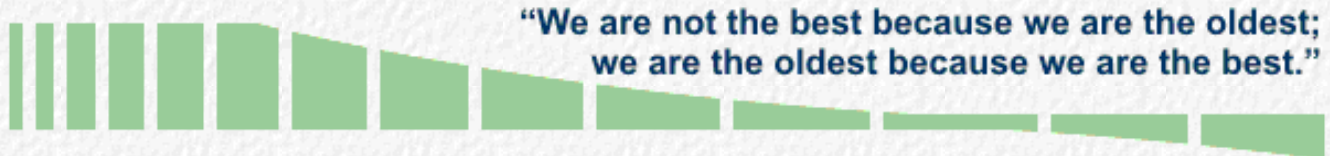

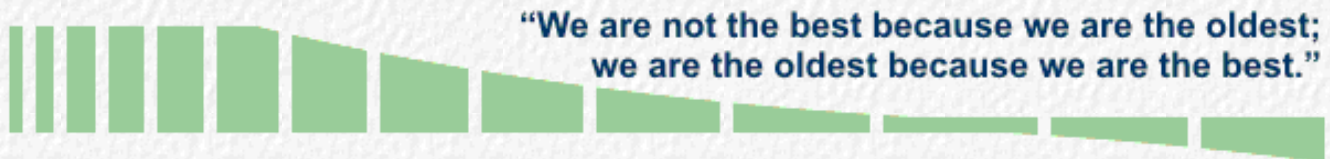

Hitch Mounted Lift Installations

Will My Vehicle Be Overloaded With a Rear Mounted Lift?

This is a simple question with a complex answer. Wright-Way will never sell or install a rear mounted lift on a vehicle that was never designed from the factory to accept the weight of the lift with a customer's power wheelchair or scooter.

The fact is that although the vehicle's body structure may be strong enough, the weight of a trailer might cause it to droop or sit lower than it should in the rear. For this reason when a new vehicle is built and it rolls off of the assembly line with a trailer hitch already installed, the factory often includes special rear suspension components, such as heavy-duty struts, springs, and shocks to support a trailer.

Every vehicle is different and not every vehicle will need to have rear suspension modifications in order to safely have a rear hitch wheelchair/scooter lift installed. A general rule is that if the rear of the vehicle is sagging before a lift is installed, it is a good bet that it will need something to allow it to ride at the factory recommended riding height after the lift is installed.

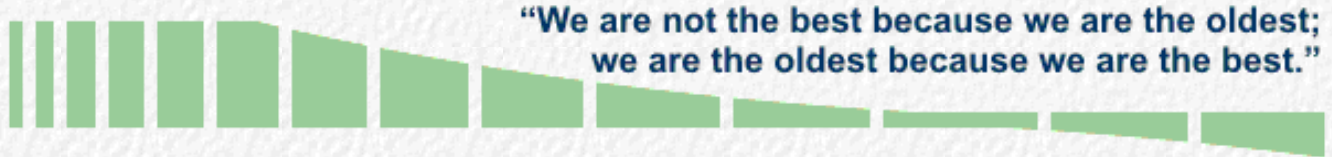
Many of the high-line luxury automobiles were built with an automatic load-leveling suspension system. With this option already installed in the vehicle and operational, additional modifications are normally not required.

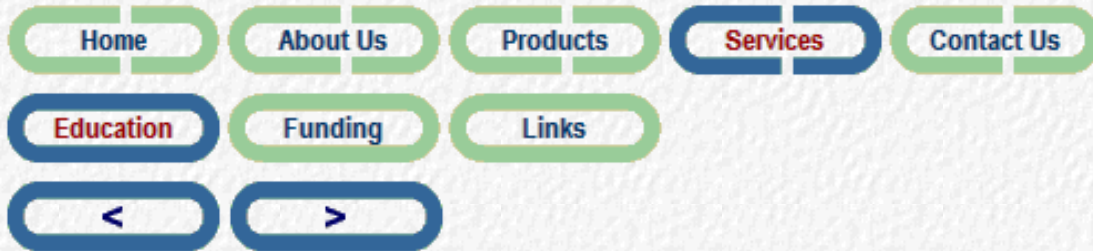

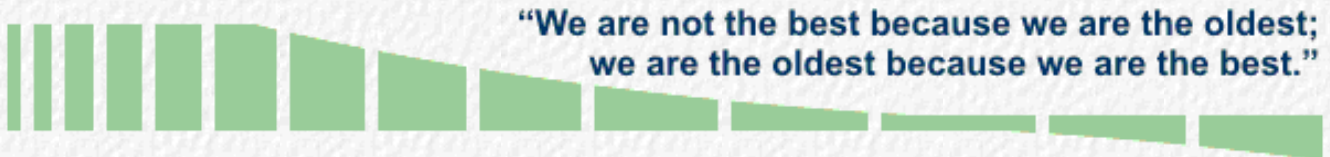

Van Wheelchair Lifts

What do I need to know when I think about purchasing one?

The very first thing to consider is height. What is the height of the person sitting in the wheelchair from the top of their head to the ground when sitting in their normal sitting position? Will My Vehicle Be Overloaded With a Rear Mounted Lift?

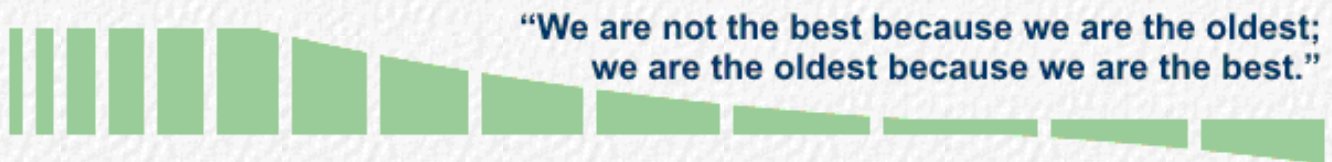
This is a simple question with a complex answer. Wright-Way will never sell or install a rear mounted lift on a vehicle that was never designed from the factory to accept the weight of the lift with a customer's power wheelchair or scooter.

The fact is that although the vehicle's body structure may be strong enough, the weight of a trailer might cause it to droop or sit lower than it should in the rear. For this reason when a new vehicle is built and it rolls off of the assembly line with a trailer hitch already installed, the factory often includes special rear suspension components, such as heavy-duty struts, springs, and shocks to support a trailer.
